

Adult Confirmation 2011



Are you thinking about being confirmed?

Perhaps you've reached a significant stage in your spiritual life. Maybe you've reached it because quite recently the Christian faith has started to make sense to you. Probably you want to receive the bread and wine at the Eucharist, and that's a reflection of a deeper longing to know God better. You may also be thinking about your place in the Church or someone else may have suggested Confirmation is something you should consider.

Whatever your reasons thinking about being confirmed, Confirmation isn't an end in it's self. It's a vital staging post on your spiritual journey.

The Adult Confirmation Course consists of twelve sessions between June and November which aim to help you commit yourself to Christ, to have knowledge of the Church and it's teachings and to resource you for your continuing journey with God.

The course is also open to those who want to refresh or discuss their faith. At the end of the course those already confirmed can choose to reaffirm their discipleship before the Bishop at the Confirmation Service.

This year Bishop Andrew Proud, the new Bishop of Reading, will be coming to baptise and confirm on evening of 18th October.
